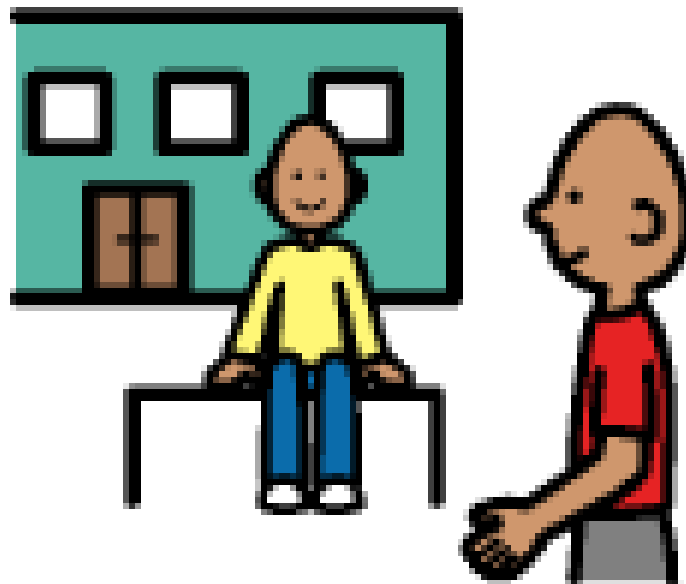


Returning To School During COVID-19

There are less people getting sick with Coronavirus.

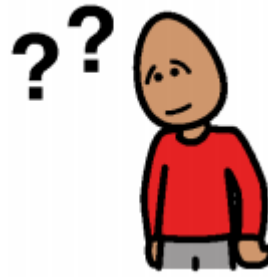


Some places will start to slowly open again. Schools are re-opening.





We will need to be careful so that we don't spread germs at school.



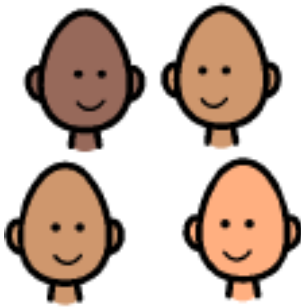
To keep everyone safe some things will be the same but some things will be different.

Some children will stay at home



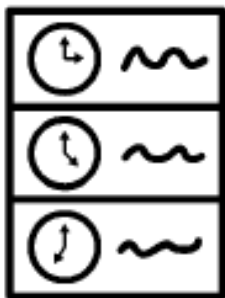
We will be in school in small groups



Parents won't be coming into the building so that we don't have too many people in school. The teachers will be ready to welcome us



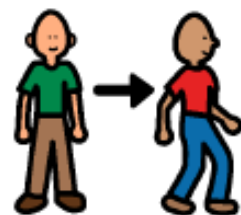
We will need to wash our hands as we come in to school and at different times throughout the day.



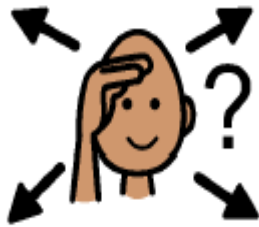
We won't be in school every day

We will line up with bigger spaces in between us.



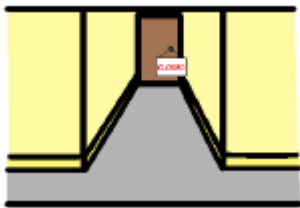
Friends might not be outside at the same time.



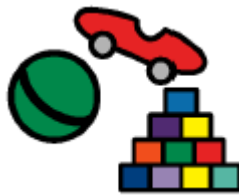
I will have a packed lunch in school

We can't share toys in the same way.



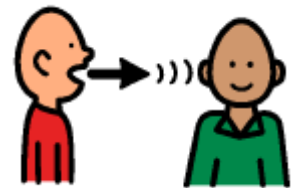
We will be given our own book to write in and our own pencils and rubbers.



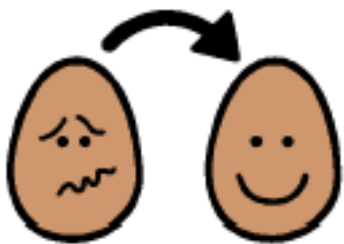
There will be lots of nice things about being in school again.
