Item Number	Item	Notes
1	School finishing times – collecting CCJ siblings	CCI asked if parents are finding pick up of CCI and CCJ siblings tricky with just 5 mins between. Parents felt the issue was with CCJ only having a pedestrian gate open and causing a bottle neck. Action: AM to remind staff to have children with CCJ sibs at the front.
2	Curriculum events with parents and children	CCI asked how sessions would be helpful. The group agreed having sessions at 3.20pm once a term where we invite ch. back in with parents would be useful. We will start with reading to support parents to hear their children read at home.
3	Reading at home	Parents felt they could do with support like watching teachers read with a child, how long to read for and some little tips. They also felt a survey would be useful to ask parents what they need help with. Action: AM to organise a survey and then some videos and personalised support from teachers.
4	Community kitchen and Christmas gift idea	The group discussed what would benefit the whole community at a tricky time. We felt a good quality toy exchange would work where people bring one toy and take one. This would be useful financially and for the environment. We'd then also ask if families want to donate a new stocking fillers or a gift for a child and ask for donations of Christmas food treats so that we can direct families who may need these. Action: AM to organise a Saturday for this and ask Governors to help run it.
