Item Number	Item	Notes
1	Supporting parents with learning at home	Parents asked if they can have the Read, write, inc phonics rhymes for digraphs as it would really help them at home. AM to organise this.
2	Engagement in PE lessons	Parents said they are surprised that children don't seem very engaged in PE and asked why this might be. AM to talk to staff about content and engagement.
3	Festivals – how much are these celebrated?	Parents asked how much we celebrate and learn about other festivals such as Eid. AM explained that we mostly do this through RE and assemblies but will try and make more of these. AM to raise profile of major festivals.
4	Arbor – children's data	Parents asked if the data on Arbor was accurate and if parents should have an explanation. AM to ask GJ to share a one page overview explaining what the data means and how they access it.
5	Photos on website	Parents asked if more photos can be shared on the website such as school trips. GJ has just set up a new system whereby staff will share photos of recent events so that GJ can put these onto the website.
6	Transition to CCJ	Y2 form – parents didn't know they needed to complete a transition form – Loo to chase from Admissions. Transition events – children would really like to visit the grounds, go to the library again and play on the equipment. They asked what the transition includes. Q&A – parents would love to be able to have an informal session with staff at CCJ to put their minds at rest. Loo to chase form and AM to contact CCJ regarding transition in additional to that planned by GJ and AD.
7	School trips	AM asked if parents find 2 trips too expensive and if they'd rather have just one in a year. Most felt not but

		suggested other ways they could help cover cost for families who can't afford it. No action
