13/20 Welcome and Apologies

Chair welcomed Governors to the meeting. Apologies received from GJ.

14/20 Declaration of Pecuniary Interests

15/20 Minutes of the last meeting

Minutes of the last meeting approved by Governors as a true reflection.

16/20 Governors Actions and Commitments

17/20 Governor Courses

A A-B undertook the induction and safeguarding training. Discussed the benefit of having courses face to face rather than online.

18/20 Governor Monitoring

Monitoring schedule shared with Governors which is mainly for staff, who have time each term to monitor their subjects which is effective. Head noted improvements can be made to ensure what has been implemented stays in place.

Termly document has been put together to be able to report the changes and the impact it has. Furthermore, pupil conferencing will show whether the impact of, for example, the right books in the library will equate to a love of learning for the children and ensuring that learning loop has been made.

Governor queried if parents or family members could come into school to support with things like maths. Covid has affected how much parents have been supporting, but this can be done.

19/20 Heads Report

Report shared with Governors prior to the meeting.

Flagged the CSP had noted regarding the curriculum that she wanted to see evidence with how the enquiry outcome linked to prior learning and the links going forwards with CCJ. Governors discussed the enquiry led curriculum and how it's varied and interesting for children.

Governor queried course of action regarding CSP recommendations if we were to challenge or disagree. Confirmed any issues would be flagged to the Alliance board.

Guidance changed last year whereby children working at greater depth did not need to be tracked. EYFS team have agreed to add in tracking in greater depth to ensure these children are identified. Governors agreed this is a positive change. Governors discussed the data which has been shared by Head.

Governors discussed part time children and the provisions for these children and possible funding and extra support. Noted the TA apprentices are being kept on until the end of the academic year to help support in EYFS.
