Spotlight on... Huggy Wuggy

- The age rating is 12+ due to the horror element. The game teaches younger audiences that their toys and other things they previously felt comfortable with are now scary and can kill them.
- Huggy Wuggy sounds like a cuddly teddy bear but the monster is actually an evil villain in the 2021 horror PC game Poppy Playtime by MOB Games. He has been seen on YouTube, Tik Tok and Roblox.
- While there's no graphic violence or gore, there are splatters of blood throughout the factory. Also, the horror nature of the game will likely be too scary for younger audiences.
